HOW TO FIND US

By Road

Royal Windsor Racecourse is on the A308 between Windsor and Maidenhead. From the M4 leave at J6 and follow the signs to Windsor.

From the M3 leave at J2 and join the M25. From the M25 J15 join the M4 to J6 and follow signs to Windsor Racecourse.

By Rail

The nearest stations to the racecourse are Windsor & Eton Central, Windsor & Eton Riverside and Slough. Trains run from Paddington and Waterloo to these stations. Taxis are available from all stations.

By Air

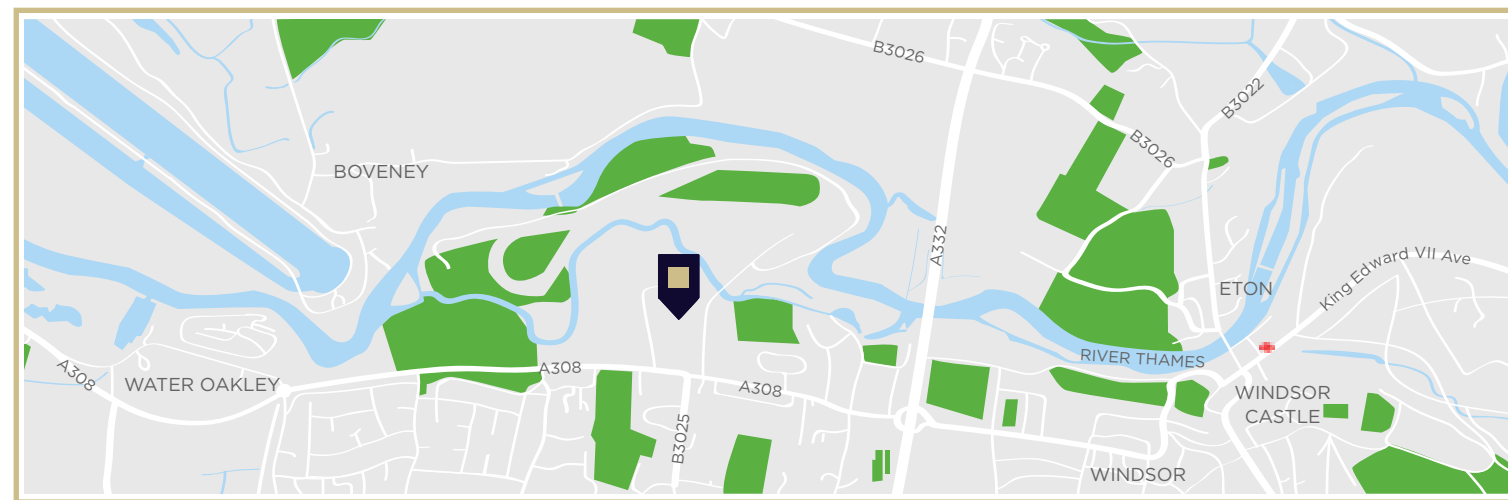
Helicopters may land on the centre course (by prior arrangement with the racecourse).

By River

A river taxi service operates for all race meetings from Barry Avenue Promenade, opposite Browns restaurant, in Windsor town centre.

This is just a short walk from both Windsor train stations. The river trip takes approximately 10 minutes and there is a full bar facility on board.
